Dear Member of Parliament

Motion of No Confidence in this Government

We the people, due to the growing instability within this country, request that a courageous Member of Parliament moves an urgent **motion of no confidence** against this Government forthwith, to be voted on when the house next sits on **Tuesday 23rd August 2022**. This motion will coincide with when The Freedoms & Rights Coalition will peacefully gather with thousands of members of the public outside Parliament. We the people, will be calling for this vote to occur!

We the people, request that a Member of Parliament urgently displays tenacity and courage with this motion, and steps up to represent a good portion of New Zealanders. When the Wellington occupation occurred in February/March 2022, not one of the 120 Members of Parliament stepped out of Parliament to listen to the concerns of the people gathered. At the time, over one-third of the country said they agreed with the protestors' call for the mandates to be removed. Democracy died that day. Members of Parliament failed in their obligation to serve ALL the people of New Zealand. At the very least, we deserved the opportunity to be heard. Now is the opportunity for an MP or a party to rectify that gross injustice.

We the people, believe that multiple sectors of our country have now reached crisis levels, and even though we pride ourselves on being Kiwi battlers, we cannot tough out another year under the control of this Government. This Government will collapse this country if they are permitted to continue governing us. It is embarrassing that approximately 1 million Kiwis are currently considering moving overseas for a better way of life.

PROTECTING THE FREEDOMS & RIGHTS OF ALL NEW ZEALANDERS.

We the people, have no confidence in Prime Minister Jacinda Ardern and her government, who have innumerable inadequacies to govern. Across every sector of society, their appalling results within our governmental departments are evidence of their inadequacies. I.e. Cost of Living Crisis, Health Crisis, Housing Crisis, Crime Crisis, Child Poverty Crisis, SMEs in Crisis, High Inflation, Homelessness Crisis, Mental Health Crisis, Agriculture Crisis, Labour Shortage Crisis, Education Crisis, and many more. Yet the most concerning is the Crisis of Trust towards this government. The public no longer has trust or confidence in this government.

We the people, believe that the culture within our present Government also needs a major reset. Under this government, there have been countless claims of bullying, racism, segregation and more including from the Speaker of the House.

We the people, believe that current Politicians and parties have lost their way in serving the people as their number one priority, instead, they over-prioritise towing the party line.

We the people, would like the immediate opportunity to go to a snap election. This will also have the added benefit of negating the need for any potential by-elections that are at a great cost to the taxpayer.
